Defendant, Glenn Hegar, in his Official Capacity as Comptroller of Public Accounts of the State of Texas, and Plaintiffs, City of Coppell, Texas; City of Humble, Texas; City of DeSoto, Texas; and City of Carrollton, Texas have agreed to the terms of a temporary injunction in the above captioned case.

By agreement of the parties, the Court hereby enjoins the Comptroller from implementing or enforcing 34 Tex. Admin. Code § 3.334(b)(5) until a final hearing on the merits or further order from this Court.

Pursuant to Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code § 6.002, no security or bond is required of Plaintiffs.

The trial on the merits in *City of Coppell, Texas; City of Humble, Texas; City of DeSoto, Texas; and City of Carrollton, Texas v. Hegar* (Cause No. D-1-GN-21-003198) is set for the week of May 2, 2022.
